Service hours are **NOT** required for graduation, but are encouraged for community involvement and required for Bright Futures and other scholarships.

Bright Futures Service Hours requirements: Students must complete a minimum of **100** service hours during high school and by high school graduation. Service hours may include, but are not limited to, a business or governmental internship, work for a nonprofit community service organization, or activities on behalf of a candidate for public office. Except for credit earned through service-learning courses, the student may not receive remuneration or academic credit for the service work performed. The student must identify a social or civic issue or professional area, develop a plan for personal involvement in addressing the issue or learning about the area, and through papers or other presentations, evaluate and reflect upon the experience.
